Core principles for working together

Who are the volunteers?

The Immunisation4life CHS volunteer is suitably qualified in the Nursing, Medical, Nutrition, Discipline and Administration support. They will have experience with working with children, are flexible and highly motivated in their work. The role of the volunteer with Immunisation4Life CHS will be to work as part of a medical team in Partnership with Immunisation4Life CHS and the in country partner, The NERI clinic. Volunteers will be accountable to the Immunisation4Life CHS field director during the trip to Lusaka, Zambia.

Openness and Transparency

Any issues that may concern the volunteer should be discussed with the Field director. There will be a reflective practice period every evening to discuss any aspects of clinical care that may arise. This will be part of ongoing training with regular meetings, reflective practise and feedback from volunteers following trip.

Confidentiality

The right to confidentiality for volunteers will always be adhered to and respected. This includes the application process, the period in Zambia and on return to Ireland.

Dental check-up at your own cost.

Malarial prophylaxes as recommended by Dr. Colohan.

Attend any meetings required by Immunisation4Life CHS regarding Child Protection, Keeping safe guidelines.

In Country protocol.

Bottled water for drinking and brushing teeth.

All food cooked.

No Salads.

Full current drivers licence

The volunteer should at all times adhere to Code of Behaviour in relation to dress code and respect for clinical and living areas. Immunisation4Life CHS living accommodation is based in a Catholic Seminary in Lusaka, so volunteers must be mindful of this fact and adhere to guidelines re. Dress code.
